

Clinical Assistant Professor – Medical Imaging Technology

The Division of Allied Health Sciences at Indiana University Kokomo invites applications for a non tenure-track position, at the Clinical Assistant Professor level commencing August 1, 2008. Responsibilities include teaching in our Radiologic Science and Medical Imaging Technology Programs. This is a 10 month position. Although teaching and clinical education are the prime responsibilities, academic advising and service are also required. The successful candidate will be responsible for maintaining didactic and clinical education per the JRCERT, ASRT and ARRT advanced certification standards.

Required qualifications include: 1) a minimum of an earned Baccalaureate degree; and 2) being registered with the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT). Desired qualifications include: 1) at least one year of experience as an instructor in a JRCERT program and a strong commitment to undergraduate education; 2) advanced certification/ education in ultrasound (RDMS or ARRT-US) or MRI; 3) one year working experience in radiology; and 4) to be eligible for Indiana licensure in General Radiography.

Applicants must submit the following: 1) a letter summarizing the qualifications and experiences she/ he wishes the search committee to consider; 2) a current complete curriculum vita; 3) official undergraduate and graduate transcripts; 4) copy of ARRT and other professional credentialing/ licensing; and 5) at least three professional letters of reference sent directly from the sources. Salary will be commensurate with experience. The review process will commence June 23, 2008; applications will be accepted until the position is filled.
