

NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

UNIVERSITY ORIENTATION

Policies, procedures and services of the university will be discussed. Representatives from Financial Aid, the IU Kokomo Bookstore, Parking, Office of Student Activities, Career Services, Computer Services, and the Bursar's office will be available to answer questions regarding their offices. The registration process will be discussed by a member of the Registrar's staff. Students will perform skits and conduct a student forum.

STUDENT FORUM/IU KOKOMO JEOPARDY

Students will give their perspectives of campus and everyone will participate in a game of IU Kokomo's Jeopardy. During University Orientation, orientation leaders will speak of their experiences at IU Kokomo and be given an opportunity to ask questions.

SKITS

Orientation leaders will act out some of their experiences as students at IU Kokomo.

PARENT SESSION

Parents will receive information about the academic and support services offered to students at IU Kokomo. Policies and procedures of the campus will be discussed. Roles parents may play in supporting students academically will also be discussed. Parents will have an opportunity to work with faculty and staff on "what if situations. Parents will be able to speak to representative from the Financial Aid and Bursar's offices.

VERIFICATION OF ADS ACCOUNTS

Students **MUST** establish ADS and IU e-mail accounts. These accounts should be established prior to orientation and registration. Students will log on to OneStart to verify their accounts. MAJOR ORIENTATIONS

Policies and procedures for the major academic units will be discussed. Students will meet with their academic advisor, be advised of the classes suggested or required for their academic plans and be instructed as to how to complete the course registration process. The advisor/advisee relationship will be discussed.

REGISTRATION

Students will register via computers. Academic advisors, orientation leaders and the registrar's staff will be available to guide students in this process. The IT staff will also be available to ensure ADS and e-mail accounts are established and working.

STUDENT I.Ds

Students are required to have an IU Kokomo student I.D. A picture I.D. is required to get an IU Kokomo student I.D. Please bring a picture ID with you to orientation. You will take your IU Kokomo ID on orientation day.
