Fees are paid according to published schedules each semester and are subject to change by action of the Indiana University Board of Trustees. A nonrefundable application fee of \$30 is charged to all credit students new to Indiana University. Rules for determining resident and nonresident student status may be found in the section entitled "University Policies."

Fees are subject to change by the Trustees of Indiana University, the vice president of finance, or the campus chancellor. (Note: Because the First Semester Schedule of Classes is printed prior to the Indiana University Trustees meeting on fees, the tuition rates and other fees listed in the First Semester Schedule may be incorrect.) Fees are due in full as billed and according to the Schedule of Classes. Tuition may be deferred by the Office of the Bursar. To qualify for a personal deferment, a student must be registered for at least six credit hours and be in good standing with the university. A minimum payment of 40 percent of semester fees, 100 percent of any other charges on the account, and a personal deferment charge is due by the due date indicated on the student's semester bill. The remaining 60 percent of semester fees may be divided equally into two payments. This balance may be paid at any time but no later than due dates specified — no later than 30 days after classes start for Payment 2 and no later than 60 days after classes start for Payment 3. The deferment is not granted to Purdue students enrolled at the campus, for summer sessions, or for late registration.

Fee Refund Schedule

Credit hour and directly related fees are refundable upon proper withdrawal from course work. Refunds are based on the following schedules.

First and Second Semester Refund Schedule
(For classes running nine weeks or longer.)

First week of classes	100% of course fees,	course-related, activity, and technology fees
Second week	75% of course fees	
Third week	50% of course fees	
Fourth week	25% of course fees	
Thereafter	None	

Summer Sessions Refund Schedule
(For classes five through eight weeks in length.)

First week of classes	100% of course fees, course-related, activity, and technology fees
Second week	50% of course fees
Thereafter	None

Refunds

Whenever registration in a course is deemed insufficient, the university reserves the right to cancel the course and refund all fees. Refunds will not be made for certain courses that are permitted to continue with low or limited registration unless the student follows withdrawal procedures. Courses that require additional fees are marked with asterisks (*) after the course description: * lab fee; ** student teaching or field experience fee.
