Bucheri, McCarty & Metz Scholarship

The **Bucheri, McCarty & Metz Scholarship** is designed to *recognize students from Howard County* enrolled at Indiana University Kokomo. The amount of the scholarship is \$500.

Recipients will be carefully selected on the basis of their academic achievements, co-curricular activities and their written essay. Financial need will not be a factor.

Eligibility:

- 1. Graduates must be enrolled for a minimum of six-credit hours in the MBA program at Indiana University Kokomo.
- 2. Must be a Howard County resident.
- 3. A one-page (or less) essay entitled: "Why I Should Be Named The Recipient of the Bucheri, McCarty & Metz Scholarship."

Terms:

- 1. Must be enrolled in the School of Business at Indiana University Kokomo.
- 2. Scholarships are to be used exclusively for educational expenses.

Business and Economics General Scholarship

The **Business and Economics General Scholarship** is designed to recognize excellence and superior scholastic performance. The amount of the scholarship is \$500. One scholarship will be awarded per year.

Recipients will be carefully selected on the basis of their academic achievements, leadership in MBA Students' Association and recommendations. Financial need will not be a factor.

Eligibility:

- 1. Must be an MBA student in the School of Business at Indiana University Kokomo.
- 2. Must have an overall 3.5 G.P.A. in 15 credit hours of MBA level (500-level) coursework.
- 3. Must not have been a recipient of this award in a previous semester.

Terms:

- 1. Must be enrolled at Indiana University Kokomo.
- 2. Scholarships are to be used exclusively for educational expenses.

Pendse Outstanding MBA Student Award

The **Pendse Outstanding MBA Student Award** is donated by former MBA Director, Professor Dilip Pendse, and is awarded annually. Candidates must be formally admitted to the MBA Program at Indiana University Kokomo. Candidates should have a record of academic excellence. The scholarship amount in general is \$500. In the case of a tie, the amount and number of scholarships to be awarded will be decided by the School of Business Scholarship Committee.

Recipients will be carefully selected on the basis of their academic achievements. Financial need will not be a factor.

Eligibility:

1. Must be enrolled as an MBA student in the School of Business at Indiana University Kokomo.
2. Must be completing the M.B.A. program requirements in spring 2008 or have already completed in summer or fall 2007.
3. Overall G.P.A. must be at least 3.7 on a 4.0 scale.
4. Must demonstrate managerial and leadership potential through participation in campus and community organizations.

Terms:

1. Must be enrolled in final or next to final semester at Indiana University Kokomo.
2. Scholarships are to be used exclusively for educational expenses.

Sita C. and C.L. Amba-Rao Graduate Service Award

The **Sita C. and C.L. Amba-Rao Graduate Service Award** is donated by Professor Sita Amba-Rao and is awarded annually. Candidates should be enrolled in the MBA Program at Indiana University Kokomo and have a record of academic excellence as demonstrated by a cumulative GPA of at least 3.2 on a 4.0 scale. In addition, students should demonstrate managerial and leadership potential through participation in campus and community organizations. Student must be enrolled in the School of Business at Indiana University Kokomo. The amount of the scholarship is \$500.

Recipients will be carefully selected on the basis of their academic achievements and co-curricular activities. Financial need will not be a factor.

Eligibility:

1. Must be enrolled as an MBA student at Indiana University Kokomo.
2. Overall G.P.A. must be at least 3.2 on a 4.0 scale.
3. Must demonstrate managerial and leadership potential through participation in campus and community organizations.

Terms:

1. Must be enrolled at Indiana University Kokomo.
2. Scholarships are to be used exclusively for educational expenses.
