Registration Guide

This guide provides a *sample plan* for student registration that demonstrates course selection to meet all requirements within four years. It is recommended that all freshman and sophomores arrange an appointment with their advisor prior to *each* registration. The Academic Advisor and the student work together as a team to determine the best class schedule. This guide does not detail courses that may be completed during summer sessions. Students interested in summer session classes would adjust their credit hours during Fall and Spring Semesters accordingly. In addition, the Academic Advisor is aware of new course options and alternative selections available in some content areas. Thus, an appointment with your Advisor each semester is highly encouraged.
