



### **What is an e-Portfolio?**

Students completing the Teacher Education Program (TEP) will document and showcase their knowledge, skills, and dispositions as teachers in an electronic format, called an e-Portfolio. Specific directions will be provided within an Introductory e-Portfolio Workshop. Introductory e-Portfolio Workshops are offered throughout the Pre-Professional sequence of classes. Basically, various documents are filed under headings which match the Metastandards. The professors and instructors of Education courses will assist students in knowing what they are responsible for entering and what could be included.

Upon acceptance into TEP, students will attend an Advanced e-Portfolio Workshop. Additional details, needed during this phase of the program, will be provided. During Benchmark IV, students submit their e-Portfolio for a Formative e-Portfolio Evaluation. The review response provides students specific input about their progress to date. A complete e-Portfolio will be produced by the conclusion of the student teaching experience and a Summative e-Portfolio Evaluation will be conducted.
