

New Media Communication BA 5-Year Plan

Assumptions

1. This plan assumes students take 40 3-credit hour courses to graduate, which is not actually the case. With 1, 4, and 5-credit hour courses existing, in some semesters the number of courses will be adjusted slightly. This is just a guideline.
2. New Media Communication does not require a minor, but one is strongly encouraged. So one is built in.
3. An internship is also strongly encouraged, either as a New Media Elective or other elective.
4. One New Media elective should be a New Media Communication writing elective.
5. It is preferred that students take certain courses in order.
 - a. N213 should be taken before N201.
 - b. N200 should be taken before N210.
 - c. All four of these should be taken before N315 or N411.

This student takes 4 courses a semester with no summer courses.
