Assistant Professor of Education

Indiana University Kokomo's Division of Education is seeking applicants for a full-time, tenure-track position in Education beginning August 2008. An earned doctorate from an accredited institution in Education is preferred; however, a minimum of ABD status is required (if hired as an ABD, the faculty member will have two years to earn the doctorate). The applicant must have a minimum of three years of bona fide full-time classroom teaching experience at the elementary-middle school/junior high-, or high school-level in a U.S. school (preferably public). Although primarily responsible for undergraduate elementary, middle school/junior high, and high school methods courses, the candidate may also teach other undergraduate and graduate education courses, to include instructional technology, and supervise student teaching. A successful candidate must: 1) demonstrate the ability to effectively teach both elementary and secondary methods courses, 2) demonstrate a commitment to diversity, 3) possess potential to carry out a program of scholarship, and 4) possess a potential for service to the University and/or profession. Prior experience in supervising student teaching and other practica experiences will be looked upon favorably. In addition, preference will be given to those candidates with experience in integrating technology and multimedia in the classroom, and with experience teaching mathematics at the elementary-, middle school/junior high-, or high school-level.

Applicants must submit the following: 1) a letter summarizing the qualifications and experiences she/he wishes the search committee to consider, 2) a current, complete curriculum vita, 3) official undergraduate and graduate transcripts, 4) at least three professional letters of reference sent directly from the source, and 5) copies of teaching credentials/professional licenses held.
