Professor and Dean

The Division of Education at Indiana University Kokomo invites applications and nominations for the position of Professor of Education & Dean of the Division, a full-time permanent position beginning July 1, 2010. The Dean functions as the senior administrator within the Division, with responsibilities for the Division's initial and advanced teacher education programs. The qualifications essential for this position are: an earned doctorate in education (Ph.D. or Ed. D.); demonstrated excellence in teaching, and the ability to teach courses within the Division's undergraduate and graduate programs; minimum of three years direct relevant professional experience within American P-12 public/private education; an understanding of and direct experience with accreditation standards, reporting and processes; an understanding of licensing and teacher certification procedures, policies, and patterns at the state level; record of university level teaching, scholarship and service in P-12 teacher education sufficient to warrant appointment at the professor level with tenure; and administrative experience at the level of department chair, or an equivalent record of program development, leadership, and administration.

In addition, candidates who bring evidence of a demonstrated commitment to diversity; the ability to provide dynamic and vigorous leadership to a growing teacher education unit; the ability to mentor and forge collaborations with university and P-12 colleagues; the ability to serve as the Division's representative to various campus, School of Education, and university level bodies; experience in P-12 teaching; demonstrated grant writing success; a strong background in technology; an understanding of and an interest in the scholarship of teaching and learning; and a commitment to and experience with globalization, will be preferred.

One of eight campuses of Indiana University, Indiana University Kokomo is a comprehensive nonresidential campus located 50 miles north of Indianapolis in Kokomo, Indiana, a city with a population of about 48,000. Committed to student success, the campus serves approximately 2,800 students from an 11-county area in north central Indiana. An additional 220 students pursue degrees in technology in cooperation with Purdue University. IU Kokomo has approximately 240 faculty and staff and 125 part-time employees.
