### **Lecturer in Early Childhood / Elementary Education**

Indiana University Kokomo's Division of Education is seeking applicants for a full-time lecturer position in Early Childhood/Elementary Education. This is a continuing ten-month appointment with only teaching and service responsibilities beginning August 2008. A master's degree in education and at least three years of bona fide full-time classroom teaching experience in a U.S. elementary or early childhood classroom (NAEYC accredited program or public school preferred) is required. Candidates must be able to teach undergraduate courses in the areas of: 1) early childhood curriculum and instruction (P-3); 2) elementary curriculum and instruction (K-6); 3) methods of early childhood education; and 4) methods of elementary education. Although primarily responsible for undergraduate early childhood and elementary pre-professional and professional education courses, the candidate may also teach other undergraduate education courses, and supervise student teaching. In addition, the candidate will be expected to collaborate with, and provide support for, the Indiana University Kokomo Center for Early Childhood Education, and engage in Division, University, and community service. Preference will be given to applicants with experience teaching at the university level in a teacher preparation program.

Applicants must submit the following: 1) a letter summarizing the qualifications and experiences she/he wishes the search committee to consider, 2) a current, complete curriculum vita, 3) official undergraduate and graduate transcripts, 4) copies of teaching credentials/professional licenses held, and 5) at least three professional letters of reference sent directly from the source.
