**TENURE TRACK ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN HEALTH MANAGEMENT**

The School of Public and Environmental Affairs (SPEA) at Indiana University Kokomo is seeking applicants for a tenure track Assistant Professor in Health Management. The position will begin on August 1, 2010.

**PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

This is a tenure track position requiring the ability to teach courses in health care management, managerial epidemiology, public management, health policy analysis, health service delivery, hospital administration, and other related areas. Faculties at IU Kokomo teach three courses per semester. Evidence of effecting teaching, publication and a record of service will be required for tenure and promotion.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

Candidates must have an earned doctorate in Health Management, Public Health or related field. All candidates must have a record of effective college teaching, a demonstrated familiarity with new instructional technologies, a commitment to diversity, and a strong interest in curriculum development and student mentoring.

Preference will be given to candidates with management experience in health administration.
