### Guides to the Literature

***Education: A Guide to Reference and Information Sources*** Ref LB 15 .B89 2000

This guide provides descriptions of the principle sources of information in education and related fields arranged by subject. Titles listed include major guides, bibliographies, indexes, abstracts, online databases and periodical titles.

### Directories and Guides

***American Universities and Colleges*** Ref LA 226 .A65 17<sup>th</sup> ed 2006

This two-volume set lists over 1,900 postsecondary institutions. Information included for each school includes address, enrollment, accreditation, admission requirements, fees, student life, library collections and degrees offered as well as other important information. There is one section that discusses various aspects of professional education in the U.S.

***Black American Colleges and Universities*** Ref LC 2781 .H54 1994

This book is a comprehensive guide to 118 historically and/or predominantly black colleges and universities in the United States. Included in the book is information on admissions, financial aid and notable alumni.

***College Blue Book*** Ref L 901 .C677 (also available: *Online* through IUCAT)

This 6-volume reference set covers the following topics: 1.) narrative descriptions of over 4000 colleges and universities in the United States and Canada, 2.) tabular data about costs, accreditation, enrollment figures, faculty, administrative staff, 3.) degrees offered by college and subject, 4.) occupational education, 5.) scholarships, fellowships, grants and loans, and 6.) distance learning programs.

***Indiana School Directory*** Ref LB 2803.I6 A3

This resource lists all Indiana public and nonpublic schools including charter, special education and vocational-technical schools. Also included is information on the Indiana Department of Education, Indiana State Board of Education, State Levels Boards and Commissions and Special Schools and Programs. The names and addresses of key school officials are included in the directory.

***Patterson's American Education*** Ref L 901 .P3

This book lists the most current information on public and private schools in the United States. Schools listed include middle schools, junior high schools, Junior-Senior High Schools, High Schools, K-12 Schools and Vocational-Technical Schools.

***Peterson's Graduate Programs in Business, Education, Health, Information studies, Law & Social Work*** Ref L901 .P46 40<sup>th</sup> ed., v.6 2006

This reference work lists over graduate programs in disciplines and gives complete information on entrance and degree requirements, expenses, financial aid and programs of study.

***Study Abroad*** Ref LB 2338 .S86 2004-2005

This reference is an international guide to higher-education study opportunities available in over 145 countries. Information on courses and scholarships in different higher-education academic and professional disciplines is included.

### **Encyclopedias and Dictionaries**

***Concise Encyclopedia of Special Education*** Ref LC 4007 .E53 2002

This one-volume reference is a comprehensive resource in the field of special education. Some of the topics covered include bilingual education, early childhood education, gifted education, rehabilitation, special education parent and child rights and traumatic brain injury.

***Dictionary of Special Education and Rehabilitation*** Ref LC 3957 .D53 1997

This reference provides short, clear definitions for more than 2,000 terms related to the field of special education and rehabilitation. It also provides listings of professional organizations and resources such as periodicals and journals.

***Encyclopedia of American Education*** Ref LB 17 .U54 2001

This 3-volume reference set contains more than 2,000 detailed entries on almost all aspects of education. Information covered includes education and reform movements, legal issues and landmarks, bilingual education, violence and crime in schools as well as many other topics.

***Encyclopedia of Education*** Ref LB 15 .E47 2003 (also available: *Online* through IUCAT)

This 8-volume reference work contains more than 850 comprehensive articles on education within the United States and the world. Biographical information is provided on 121 influential educators.

***Greenwood Dictionary of Education*** Ref LB 15 .G68 2003

This reference provides authoritative definitions for over 2,600 educational terms.

***International Encyclopedia of Education*** STACKS LB 15 .I569 1994

This 12-volume reference work presents scholarly articles that provide an international overview of all major aspects of education. Some of the major fields included are adult education, economics of education, educational technology and sociology of education.

***Learning Theories, A to Z*** Ref LB 15 .L4695 2002

This reference provides information on 532 theories of education related to K-12 education, higher education and industry education and training environments. There is

an annotated bibliography providing additional resources to important literature on learning theories.

### **Handbooks**

***Handbook of Reading Research*** STACKS LB 1050 .H278 1984

This is a three volume set. Volumes I examined reading from a psychological framework. Volume II looked at reading from a sociological and anthropological viewpoint. Volume III focused on literacy research worldwide, methods of research, literacy processes, practices and policies.

***Handbook of Research on Multicultural Education*** STACKS LC 1099.3 .H35 1995

This one-volume reference discusses the major research and scholarship related to multicultural education. The handbook is divided into eleven major areas including history, research, knowledge construction, ethnic group history, immigration policy, ethnic group education, language issues, academic achievement, school reform, higher education and international perspectives.

***Handbook of Research on Teaching*** STACKS LB 1028 .H315 1985

This one-volume reference is divided into the following topics: the theory and method of research on teaching, research on teaching and teachers, the social and institutional context of teaching, adapting teaching to differences among learners and research on teaching subjects and grade levels.

***Handbook of Research on Teacher Education*** STACKS LB 1715 .H274 1996

A one-volume reference published by the Association of Teacher Educators examines the following topics: teacher education as a field of study, recruitment, selection and initial preparation for teachers, contextual influences on teacher education, teacher education curriculum, continuing professional growth, diversity and equity issues and emerging directions in teacher education.

### **Statistics**

***Almanac of American Education*** Ref LA 217.2 .A45

This one volume reference of educational statistics is compiled from official U. S. government and reliable private sources. It includes current and historical school enrollment tables, current and historical attainment tables, region and state education statistics and county education statistics. Older editions are available in the Stacks. Older editions of ***Education Statistics of the United States*** are also available in the Stacks LA 201 .E38.

The [National Center for Education Statistics](#) provides several annual reports including the [Condition of Education](#) and the [Digest of Education Statistics](#) both which are available as online resources. Older editions may also be available in the Government Publications collection. Check IUCAT for call numbers.

[Projections of Education Statistics to ...](#) Online Electronic Resource

This online resource provides projections for key education statistics including enrollment, graduates, teachers and expenditures in elementary and secondary schools and degree-granting institutions. National data on enrollment and graduates for the past 14 years is included as well as projections. State-level information on enrollment and graduates of private schools are not included.

[Statistical Abstract of the United States](#) Ref HA 202 .A3 (also available: *Online* through IUCAT)

This resource provides statistical tables and charts related to many aspects of American life. State rankings relating to population, health, education, employment, public aid, social security, income, crime, energy, business, federal funds and motor vehicles are provided.

### **Scholarships, Funding, and Grants**

***Annual Register of Grant Support*** Ref LB 2338 .A615

This reference lists over 3,400 grant support programs that provide financial assistance to individuals and/or organizations. Indexes are available by subject, organization and program, geography and personnel.

***College Student's Guide to Merit and Other No-Need Funding*** Ref LB 2337.2 .C64 2005-2007

This is a reference listing over 1200 merit scholarships and other non-need funding programs for currently enrolled and returning college students. These programs do not consider income level in the selection process. Only programs offering at least \$1,000.00 per year scholarships and those that do not have to be repaid are listed.

***Grants Register*** Ref LB 2338 .G7

This one-volume reference lists over 3,700 post-graduate, professional, or advanced vocational training awards from 47 countries. The **Grants Register** provides comprehensive, up-to-date information regarding the availability of awards as well as the eligibility requirements.

### **Bibliographies**

***A Guide to Sources of Educational Information*** STACKS Z 5811 .W65 1982

This is an older reference book that provides access to major education sources. More than 700 print and non-print sources are described.

***Core List of Books and Journals in Education*** STACKS Z 5811 .O37 1991

This reference lists approximately 1,000 books and journals that constitute a basic educational reference collection. Eighteen broad areas of education are represented in the collection.

***Education Index: A Cumulative Author and Subject Index to a Selected List of Educational Periodicals, Books, and Pamphlets*** INDEXES Z 5813 .E23 1929-1997

This reference is a cumulative index to educational publications in the English language.

This resource is a biographical dictionary published by Gale. It includes information on approximately 120,000 living persons in the fields of the physical and biological sciences.
