

### **How do I get an application for the nursing major and what are the deadlines?**

The application form is not posted online. You must be admitted to Indiana University and advised by an academic advisor before the end of January each year to receive an application for the fall semester.

Applications are mailed by the end of the first week in February to those who meet the **minimum** eligibility requirements. Students may choose to apply for either the fall or spring semester.

Students are given 30 days to return applications. Students applying for fall will be notified of their selection by the end of April.

Students applying for spring will have until July 1 to apply. Selected candidates will be notified by mail the first week in August.

***If you are admitted to IUK and/or advised after the deadline for fall application, it is your responsibility to contact an advisor at the Office of Advising for Allied Health and Nursing to request an application for spring.***

Admission to the nursing program is based upon the student's GPA on the courses required to apply. A GPA of at least 2.7 out of 4.0 on the courses required to apply is the minimum acceptable GPA. Students must also have a minimum overall campus GPA of at least 2.5 out of 4.0.

Generally, 50-60 students are accepted each semester.
