Must have GPA of 2.7 on a 4.0 scale in courses required in the major and 2.5 overall IU GPA for admission (minimum). Must earn a C (2.0) or above on each course by the second completed attempt. May repeat no more than 3 courses totaling 11 credits in the application courses to earn a C (2.0) or higher. Of the 3 courses, only 2 failures will be allowed in science coursework. For the School of Nursing, Grades below a C are failing: C- is failing. Total number of required credits/hours must be met in each General Education area.		
	Fine, Performing, and Communication Arts	ADMISSION TO THE BSN PROGRAM: Admission to the School of Nursing is a competitive process. Students who are admitted as unconditional freshmen to IU Kokomo and who will complete at least 2 full time semesters of pre nursing coursework at IU Kokomo have a secured place in the nursing major, so long as all prerequisite coursework is completed according to admission standards. Students starting IU Kokomo as freshman admits who are unable to meet the admission requirements within 18 months will no longer be considered direct admits, but are still eligible to apply under category 1 when they become eligible.
