IUKSGA Qualifications Notice

It is the responsibility of the applicant to secure this notice and ensure that all applicable qualifications are satisfied. IUKSGA is not obligated to relax the requirements for admission to Student Government.

Pursuant to the IUKSGA Bylaws Document, Title VII, Section 2, Parts C through F.

- C. The Executive President, and Executive Vice President shall meet the following qualifications:
 - 1. Accumulated at least thirty-five (35) credit hours of college credit,
 - 2. Must be taking and maintain at least six (6) credit hours at IUK,
 - 3. Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 at the time of the election, and
 - 4. Must maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA throughout their entire term of office.
 - 5. Non-compliance with the above standards may affect the removal of the Executive President, or Executive Vice President. Except as stated in Article XII.

- D. The Vice President of Athletics and Vice President of Programming shall meet the following qualifications:
 - 1. Accumulated at least credit Twenty-six (26) hours of college credit,
 - 2. Must have been an IUK student for one semester,
Must be taking and maintain at least six (6) credit hours at IUK,
 - 4. Must have a Cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 at the time of the election, and
 - 5. Must maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA throughout their entire term of office.
 - 6. Non-compliance with the above standard may affect the removal of the Vice President.
Except as stated in Article XII.

- E. Senators shall meet the following qualifications:
 - 1. Must be taking and maintain at least three (3) credit hours at IUK, or students who wish to be elected to the Senate who have not previously attended IUK must submit, to the Election Commission, a petition signed by twenty-five (25) students, who are enrolled in a for-credit class, before their names can be placed on the election ballot.
 - 2. Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.25 at the time of the election, and
 - 3. Must maintain at least a 2.25 cumulative GPA throughout their entire term of office.
 - 4. Non-compliance with the above standard may affect the removal of the Senator. Except as stated in Article XII.

- F. Justices of the Supreme Court shall meet the following qualifications:
 - 1. Accumulated at least credit twenty-six (26) hours of college credit,
 - 2. Must be taking and maintain at least six (6) credit hours at IUK,
 - 3. Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.50 at the time of the election, and
 - 4. Must maintain at least a 2.50 cumulative GPA throughout their entire term of office.
 - 5. Non-compliance with the above standard may affect the removal of the Justice. Except as stated in Article XII.

Pursuant to IUKSGA Constitution Document, Article IV, Section 7, Part B.

While serving as Executive President or as Executive Vice President they shall not serve as officers of any other campus organization.

IUKSGA Election Rules and Information

1. Applications will be accepted for election purposes until February 29, 2008. It is the responsibility of the candidate to secure and sign for the following documents from the Office of Student Activities or their website: Universal Application, Qualifications Notice, Election Rules, Constitution, Bylaws, and Receipt Form. Return completed applications and receipt forms **ONLY** to the Office of Student Activities, KC210, during standard business hours. Additionally, Student Activities will accept application returns by U.S. Mail postmarked prior to the deadline date. *Applications returned to any other department, location, or person shall be disqualified.*
2. It is the responsibility of the candidates to establish reliable methods of communication through which they can be contacted if IUKSGA has further questions or information. (Candidates are *strongly urged* to establish an Electronic Mail account with the IUK Computer Lab immediately.)
3. All candidates must attend a mandatory orientation meeting before the election. These meetings will be scheduled throughout March. You must sign up for a meeting in the Office of Student Activities. *Candidates who do not attend an orientation meeting will be automatically disqualified from the election.*
4. You may campaign the school week prior to the week of Elections. A platform/speech/forum opportunity may be allotted to each candidate before the elections if a position is contested and both parties would like to attend.
5. All signs and posters must be posted on cement walls with blue painter's tape. ***Post no materials on glass or wallpaper.*** It is the responsibility of the candidate to remove all campaign materials **no later than two days following Elections.**
6. General Elections will take place on Wednesday, March 26 and Thursday, March 27, 2008, in KC132.
7. Candidates are not allowed within 20 feet of the polls during the election, except to cast their own ballots or **silently** move through the area while on their way to another location. Candidates are not allowed to work the polling table or help count the votes. *Candidates who violate this rule will be disqualified from the election.*
8. The Election Commission will count the votes in the Learning Enhancement Center at 1:00 p.m. Friday, March 28, 2008. Candidates are encouraged (but not required) to witness the counting of the votes.
9. Election returns will be posted in the Office of Student Activities the day the votes are counted.
